

**Borough of Edinboro
Public Hearing Minutes
Liquor License Transfer
July 8, 2019**

ROLL CALL: Council members present were Jim Kiley, Alyssa Dobson, Fred Langill, and Mary Ann Horne. Absent were Pat Davis, Nathan Latimer, and Aaron Gast.

Other officials present were Solicitor Tim Wachter, Borough Manager Kevin Opple, and Finance Director Jason Spangenberg. Citizens present were Sam Comfort, Curtis Hals, Alex Topor, Pete Mitchell, Michael DeRiggi, and Michael Feikles.

OPENING:

Deputy Mayor Kiley called the hearing regarding a requested liquor license transfer to order at 6:21 PM.

DISCUSSION:

Pete Mitchell, Manager of the Lakeside Commons mall complex in Edinboro, spoke about their request to transfer a liquor license into the Borough for a new restaurant on the northwest corner of the mall, facing the lake. He noted that plans were to open as soon as possible, with seating capacity of less than 100, and a name had not yet been chosen for the restaurant. He added that the goal would be to operate year-round rather than seasonally, serving lunch and dinner. There would not be a stage for music but room for smaller acts such as a solo guitar. There would be the potential for the restaurant to expand into neighboring units of the mall.


COMMENTS & QUESTIONS:

Curtis Hals asked where the liquor license would be coming from, and Mr. Mitchell said that it would be coming from a closed restaurant on State Street in Erie.


ADJOURNMENT:
